Letter from A.D. Hiller, Ex. Assistant to the Administrator, Department of the Interior, Bureau of Pensions Washington D.C. While resident of Poconsink, Ulster, New York, then the home of his parents, he enlisted in the fall of 1777 and served one month as private in Captain John Newkirk's company. Colonel John Johnson's New York regiment; this service was rendered as substitute for his father. {Involved in the defense of Fort Stanck - Battle of Oreskany, Fall-1777} Henry Tice enlisted in July 1778, and served 4 months as private in said company. He enlisted in the spring of 1779 and served six months in Captain Henry Van Kuren's company, Colonel John Johnson's regiment. He enlisted again in 1780 for 3 and 1/2 months. He went out on various alarms. After the Revolutionary War, the soldier lived in Poconsink, New York for three years, and then lived about twenty years in Mamakating, Ulster, New York and finally in Chemung, Tioga, New York.

1790 census Montgomery N.Y. lists Henry Tice, Radleys and Harts in the same area (Orange Co. or Ulster Co). Some reports say that he may have been part of Sullivan military excursion in Canada. Tice members were frequently buried in Phillipsport Cemetery Sullivan Co., NY by the Old D & M Canal, but graves of Henry and Huldah are in the mountains in Spring Glen where he was raised.

Henry said they left him like he was almost standing still, and to take a little bit of the curse and the shame off, he played like he had fallen and that lost the race for him.
