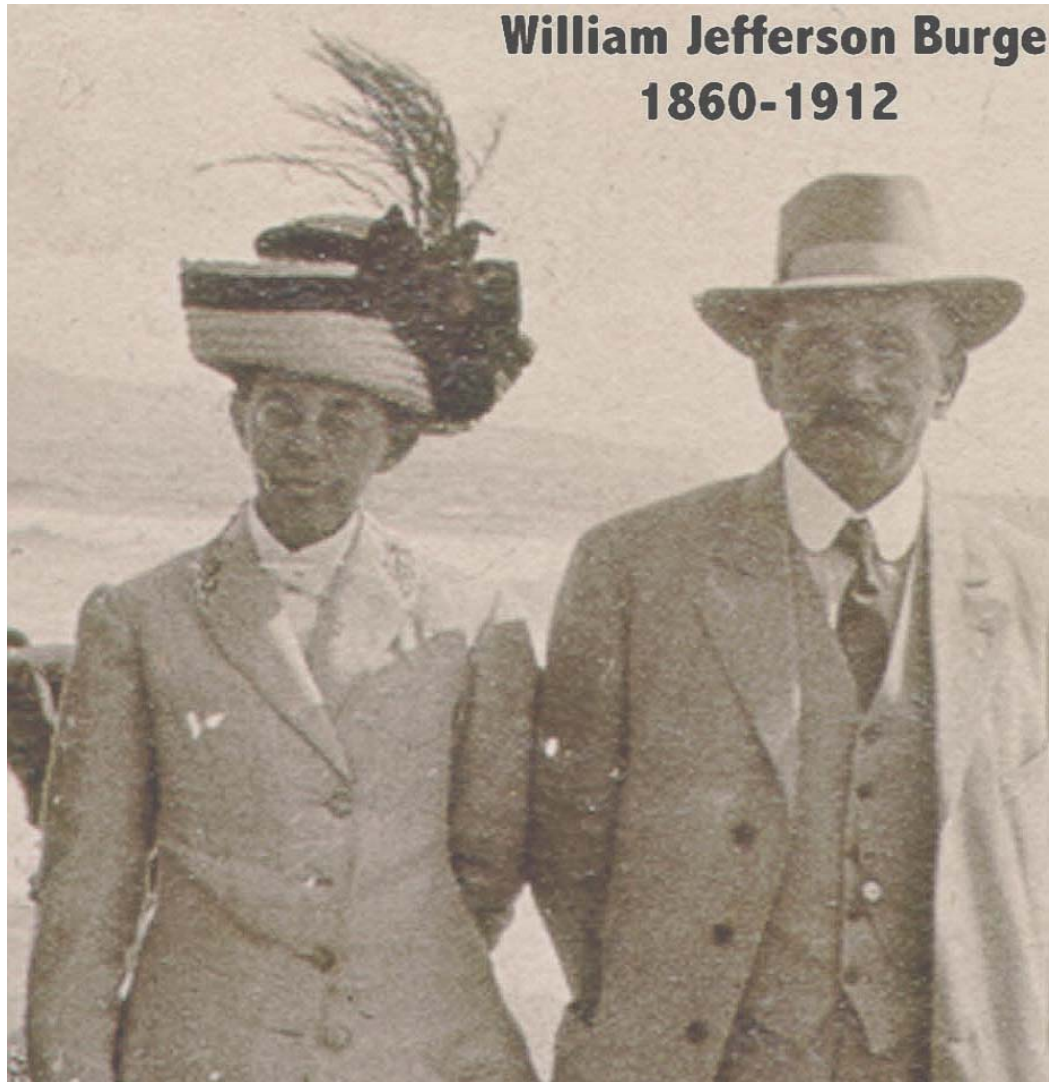

Julina H Winbourn

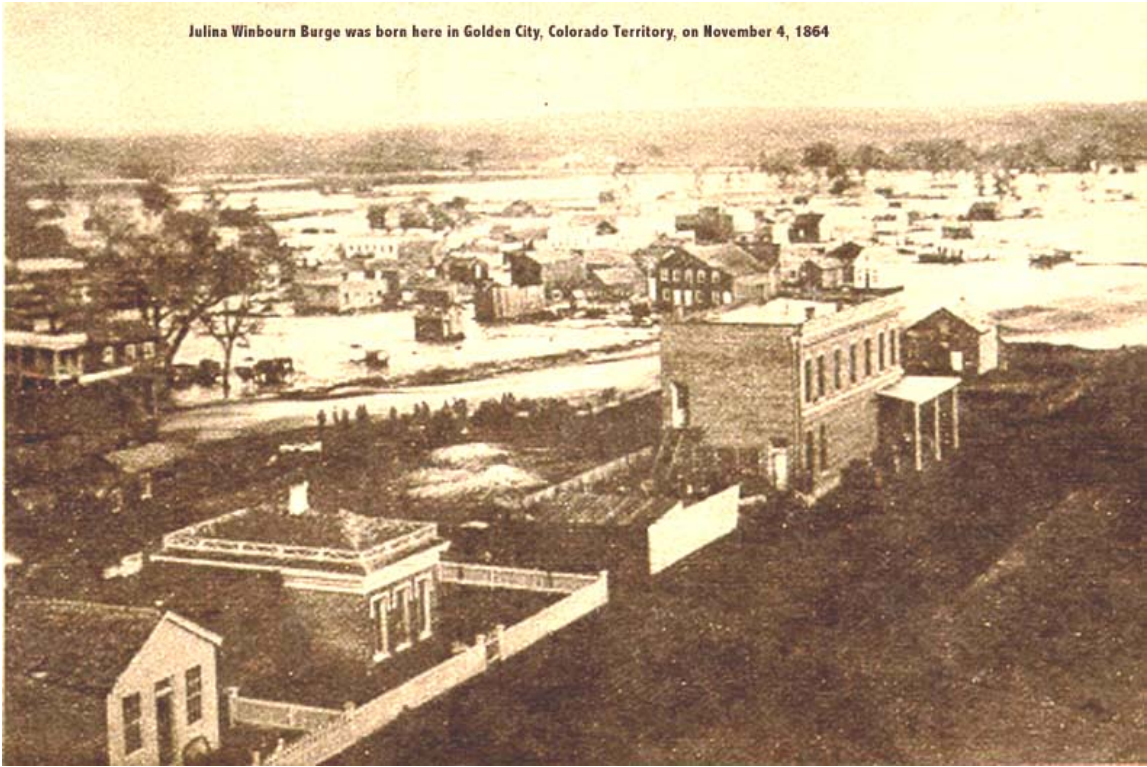
1864 - 1938

Republican, Seventh District

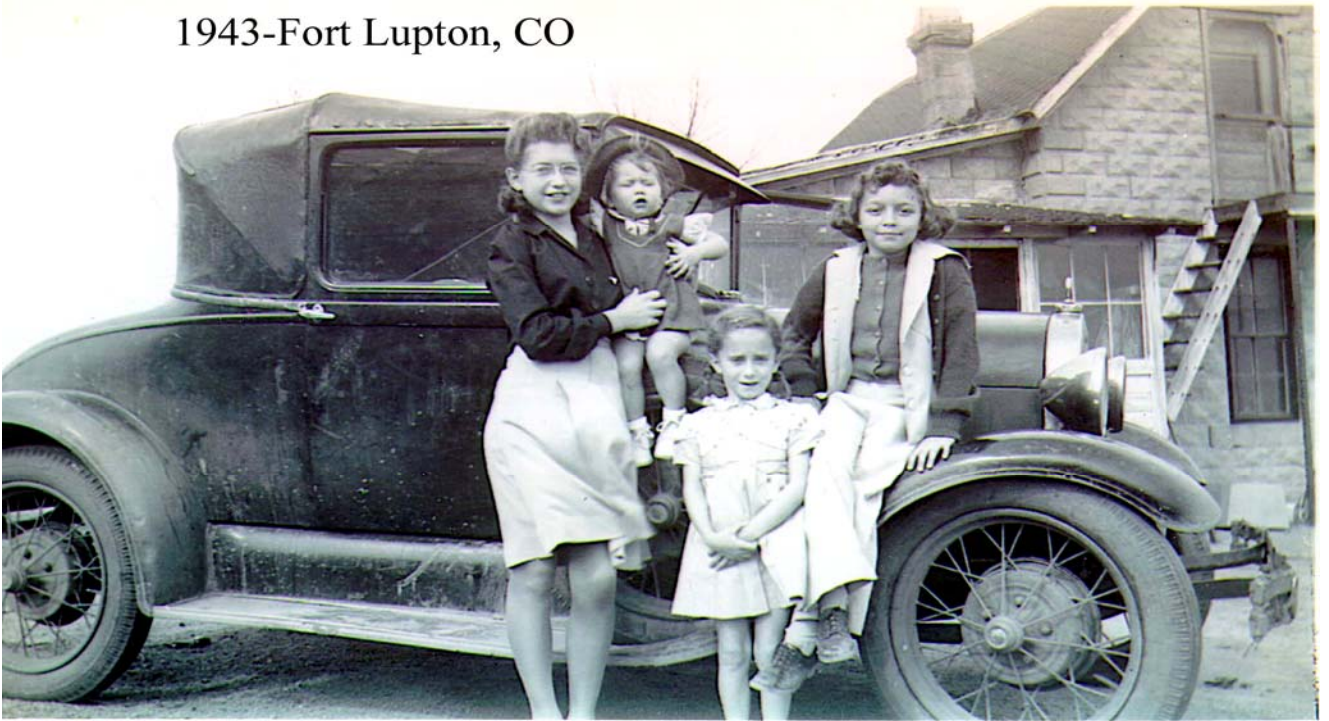


WHEN former Congressman Robert W. Bonyng went to Washington to represent the First Colorado District in 1904, he took with him as his private secretary Robert E. Winbourn, a bright and ambitious Colorado native son who even then could see "law" and "politics" written in his horoscope. Winbourn entered the law department of George Washington University almost immediately and graduated in 1907, receiving the degree of LL.B. When he returned to Denver in 1909 he was a Special Prosecutor in the public lands department of the Federal Government. In 1911 he went back to Weld County, his former home, he having been born on a ranch there, July 2, 1882. During his boyhood he was a chum of the present Attorney General, Fred C. Farrar. Senator Winbourn received his early education in the Fort Lupton and Greeley schools. He also attended Denver University for a short time. Senator Winbourn served as County Attorney of Weld County in 1911 and 1912. He is a Republican without qualifications. Although one of the youngest members of the Senate, he heads the Senate Committees on Insurance and Reapportionment. Most of the bills introduced by him relate to good roads, taxation, and a State agricultural experiment station for the investigation and treatment of plant diseases—matters all dear to the hearts of his constituents. He is the Exalted Ruler of the Greeley lodge of Elks, a delegate to the 1915 Grand Lodge of that order at Los Angeles; a Mason, and has held all the chairs in his Knights of Pythias lodge, including that of Chancellor Commander. During the session he was initiated a member of the Sons of Colorado.
