

HART TO HARTT SUPPLEMENT

EBENEZER HART (1773- ?)

(Ebenezer, Samuel, Samuel, Isaac)

Ebenezer was born in Deerfield, Mass., April 22, 1773, son of Ebenezer and Sarah (Pool) Hart; married at Deerfield, Sept. 27, 1795, Miss Esther Robbins, born Sept. 18, 1773, in Deerfield, daughter of Joseph Robbins.

Mr. Hart settled at Shelburne Falls, Mass., a carpenter by trade, and died Dec. 24, 1857, age 84 years, 8 months, 2 days. His wife died at Greenfield, Mass., Sept. 14, 1864, age 91 years.

HALLOWAY L. HART (1804-1870)

(Halloway, Ebenezer, Ebenezer, Samuel, Samuel, Isaac)

Halloway Long Hart born in Shelburne, Mass., Oct. 4, 1804, fourth son of Ebenezer and Esther (Robbins) Hart; married April 14, 1830, Mary Carter, born 1806, in Warwick, R. I., daughter of Benjamin and Mary (Burnett) Carter. She died May 10, 1835, and he married second March 16, 1836, Eliza L. Roota, born June 14, 1807, in Montague, Mass., daughter of Solomon and Nancy R. Root.

Mr. Hart resided for a time at Shelburne, and afterwards at Greenfield, Mass., a carpenter by trade. He died of

consumption, June 12, 1870, age 65 years, 8 months, 8 days. His widow died March 7, 1884, age 76 years, 8 months, 23 days, at Montague, Mass. All children were born in Shelburne, Mass.

CHARLES D. HART (1831-1897)

Charles Dwight Hart was born in Shelburne, Mass., Jan. 12, 1831, oldest son of Halloway L. and Mary (Carter) Hart; married at Greenfield, Mass., May 1, 1853, Lucy Reed Jenkins, born July 4, 1835, in Ashfield, Mass., daughter of David Hersey and Hannah (Lilly) Jenkins. She died Feb. 12, 1867, and he married second, July 11, 1867, Katherine Stow Wright, born March 27, 1847, in Greenfield, Mass., daughter of William S. and Maria Fanny (Hopkins) Wright of Ashton, Ill.

Charles went West to Franklin Grove, Ill., and Bradford, Ill. Was a farmer, and died April 14, 1897, of pneumonia. His widow is living (1900) at Bradford, Ill., and carries on the home farm.
