

## ELIZABETH (HARTT) TICE

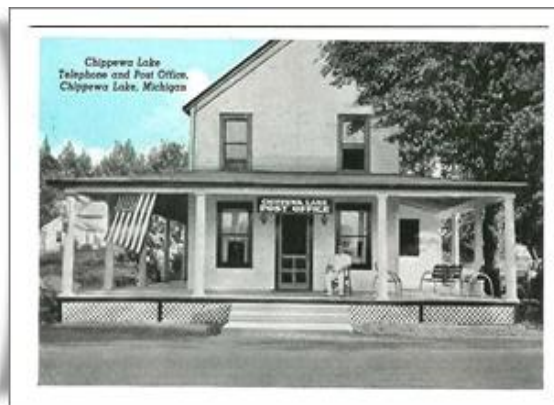
### ELIZABETH (HARTT) TICE (1818-1888)

(Elizabeth, Jonathan, Thomas A., Jonathan, Samuel, Isaac)

Elizabeth was born August 27, 1818 or 1822 in New Brunswick, Canada. Her parents were Jonathan and Jemina Hartt—She lived in Mecosta County, Mi. in 1870, and died November 28, 1888 in Barryton, Mecosta Co., Michigan. Elizabeth married SOLOMON VAN GORDER TICE Abt. 1835 in Hamilton, Wentworth Co., Ontario, Canada, son of Henrick and Huldah Van Gorder. New York - living in Mecosta County, Michigan in 1870, and died 1887 in Barryton, Mecosta Co., Michigan. Burial: Eaton Cemetery Mecosta County, Michigan.

### SOLOMON VAN GORDER TICE

Solomon was born March 18, 1810 (or 1818) in Stevens Landing, Elmira, Chemung Co., New York, and died February 07, 1887 in Barryton, Fork Twp., Mecosta Co., Michigan. He married (1) Aurelia Fox, she was born ca. 1812 in Ontario, Canada. He met (2) unknown. He married (3) ELIZABETH HARTT ca. 1835 in Hamilton, Wentworth Co., Ontario, Canada. Solomon Van Gorder Tice was one of the earliest settlers in the Barryton area. He and his wife, Elizabeth Hartt, and their children came to Barryton from Canada by way of Yale, Michigan. In 1861, they took up a homestead just east of Eaton Cemetery on the Chippewa Lake Road. Solomon was the first Post Master in the area. He rode on horseback to Big Rapids to pick up the mail, which the other settlers would get from his house. The nearest towns were Big Rapids, Sherman City, and Evert.

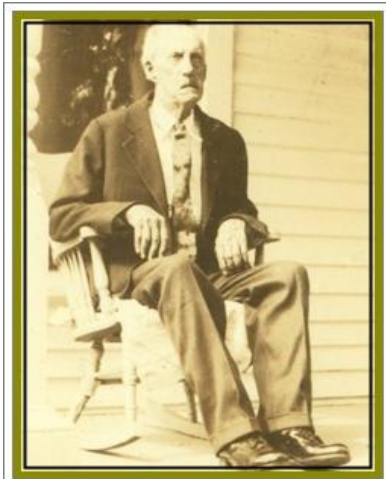

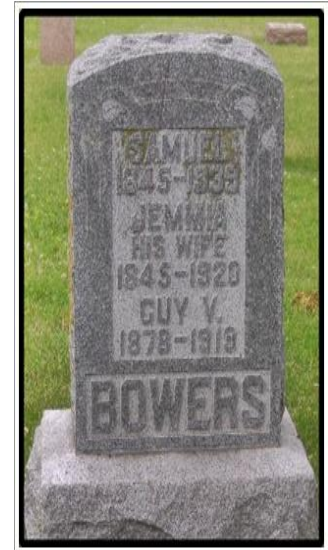

Their son, Lyle, lived on the Washington coast for several years during WW2, but returned to Iowa after the war. Ethel and Edwin divorced in their 60s or 70s. day. (According to Lloyd Tice brother to Arthur) Arthur Tice family experienced poverty and starvation and had to eat pork and Johnnie. Arthur went to work for Guy Bowers (son of Sam Bowers, in the road grading business in Iowa. Arthur was sent to various states and he would be gone for the winter and then come back. Arthur got a team of horses and was all set to go into business and Marie had the cook shack. She would cook for the men. The automotive machinery came in just when he had his team finally bought. ## **PHEBE LUCRETIA (TICE) CONDON 1846- 1931**

(Phebe, Elizabeth, Jonathan, Thomas A., Jonathan, Samuel, Isaac)



Phebe Lucretia Tice was born to Elizabeth & Solomon Tice, Nov 18, 1846. Phoebe married JAMES CONDON in Chicago, Illinois, December 20, 1865. John and Elizabeth Condon (brother of the groom and sister of the bride) were the witnesses. The couple lived in Mecosta County, Michigan for a number of years and then moved to Omaha, Nebraska (living briefly in Idaho and Colorado). Four children died at a young age. James died March 19, 1917. Phebe died May 19, 1931. Phebe and James are buried in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, Omaha, Douglas Co. Nebraska.

**Mrs. Phoebe L. Condon**, Omaha 84 Years, died Tuesday morning, May 19, 1931 at the family residence, 2814 South 32nd street, following a brief illness, She had been a resident of Omaha and the South Side for 34 years. She was the widow of James Condon, civil war veteran and government employee, who died in 1917. In later years she was active in the Women's Relief Corps.

Surviving, two daughters, Miss Jessie Condon, a teacher at Webster school, and Mrs. Stephen J. Welsh; four sons, James, Daniel and Roy of Omaha, and Parnell of San Diego, California.

Funeral at residence at 8:30 o'clock Thursday morning then to Our Lady of Lourdes church at 9 o'clock, with burial in Holy Sepulcher cemetery.

*Jim Condon enlisted three times under different names. He would desert, then someone would offer him \$100.00 to go in his place and he would soon run away again. They called it "jumping the bounty." One time, he and a Negro jumped from a boat on the Detroit River and swam to shore. Jim swam with gold watch in his mouth. Once he came near he was caught. He went home and while soldiers were searching his house, he hid under some junk in the attic. Grandpa Tice (Solomon II {1847-1913}) used to say, "Miserable, miserable man." He got an honorable discharge and drew a pension.*

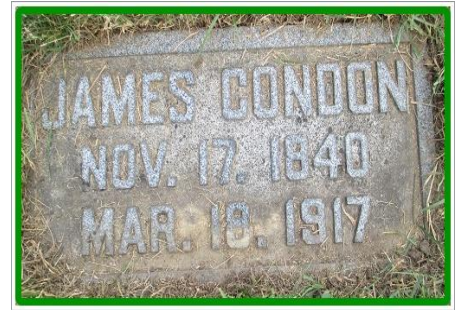

**JAMES CONDON, CIVIL WAR VETERAN, IS DEAD**

**James Condon**, 76 years, died at his home, 2308 J Street, Sunday morning after a long illness. The deceased was a resident of the South Side for thirty-two years. He was a civil war veteran and a member of the Grand Army. For many years he was government meat inspector. He was one of the first meat inspectors named for the grading contractor in this section of the state and after retiring was made a South Side. He retired from the government service six years ago.

The wife of the deceased and four sons and two daughters survive. The sons are James M., Parnell W., Daniel J., and Roy B. The daughters are Mrs. Margaret Welsh and Miss Jessie Condon. A sister of the deceased, Mrs. James McCann, resides in the South Side.

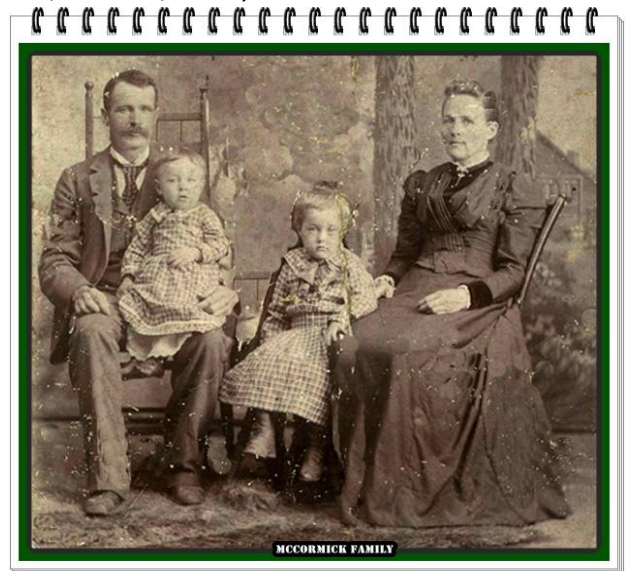
